3. General Information Business English Program

4. Academic program

4.1 Course

The participants will be taught in small groups of around 10 students to get the chance to improve their English skills in the most effective way. 2 weeks before the start of the program the participants have to send the self assessment test to give the lecturers an overview about their skills, an other test in the first unit will evaluate the result. All participant will make a final exam at the end of the three weeks to get an certificate.

5. Trips

During the three trips the participants will visit some of the most beautiful landscapes of the world. The trip to Swakopmund will give the students the chance to try dune boarding, quad biking or sky diving and a boat cruise will bring them to dolphins and seals. The second weekend will bring the group to the Etosha national park with its unique wildlife. The last trip will show the participants the fascinating landscape of the Namib desert.
