



Call For Papers

It is our pleasure to announce you the Call for Papers for the International **web-based** Conference "**ENTREPRENEURSHIP IN TURBULENT TIMES**", which will be held on 29-30 August 2016, in Chania, Crete, Greece. We invite any academic researcher, educator and practitioner seeking to promote knowledge, stimulate dialogue and set trends, in the field of entrepreneurship, education and management in entrepreneurship and gender issues in entrepreneurship to submit **extended abstracts or full papers**. **Authors can have a web-based presentation from distance through the conference web-platform.**

Sub-themes: Entrepreneurship innovation, the role of government in entrepreneurship growth, the role of education in entrepreneurship growth, Crowdfunding, Venture capitals and the role in entrepreneurship, Angel-investors, Social Entrepreneurship, Gender and Entrepreneurship, Mentoring, Organizational Culture.

English is the official conference language and all articles have to be written in formal English.
